



NOTICE OF RACE
2019 Prince Henry Race
Twenty Hundred Club
Saturday August 24th, 2019 0900

1. RULES

- a. The organizing authority is the Twenty Hundred Club.
- b. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020*.
- c. RRS 52 (Manual Power) is modified such that power-driven winches and furlers are permitted.
- d. The protest committee may impose a penalty other than a DSQ which may include a warning. This changes rule 64.1.
- e. The Race Committee is provided by the Twenty Hundred Club.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- a. The Race is open to all monohull yachts with a current PHRF-NB rating.
- b. Identifying numbers must be displayed on the mainsail.

3. ENTRY PROCEDURES & FEES

- a. Participants must register with either the Twenty Hundred Club on their website (www.twentyhundredclub.org).
- b. Yachts may participate in the following classes:
 - i. Spinnaker
 - ii. Non-Spinnaker (Cruising)

4. EVENT HEADQUARTERS

- a. NA

5. SCHEDULE

- a. Racing will begin at 0900 on Saturday, August 24th. Other details of the race schedule will be announced in the sailing instructions.
- b. A preliminary scratch sheet will be posted at www.twentyhundredclub.org by Wednesday, August 21st. A final scratch sheet will be posted in the morning of Friday, August 23rd.

6. RACING

- a. There is one race with 2 classes (spinnaker and non-spinnaker).
- b. There is no fixed course, only defined marks that may be rounded in any sequence to ensure an arrival at the finish line in the vicinity of Allen's Harbor entrance by 1530. There are six potential starting locations scattered around the bay. The 2019 SI will provide details.

7. DOCKAGE & MOORINGS

- a. Arranged by competitors as required. THC is considering a post-race event at a site near the finish. Details forthcoming.

8. SCORING

- a. The Low Point Scoring System Appendix A of the Racing Rules will apply, as modified by the sailing instructions.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- a. No changes.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a. The sailing instructions will be available on www.twentyhundredclub.org not later than August 12th.

11. PRIZES

- a. Awards will be presented at the Twenty Hundred Club Spring Dinner to be announced separately.

12. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

- a. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authorities will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- b. Each competitor participating in the regatta shall submit an online Liability and Media Waiver (a part of the Twenty Hundred Club registration process) prior to racing.
- c. Participants will be required to use Race Qs at www.raceqs.com to self-report your race (this is in addition to the regular log sheet submission as in previous years). A free account for your boat is required. A free iOS or Android app is required.
